## Kentucky's Gross Domestic Product

Definition: Gross Domestic Product by State (GDP by State) is the value added in production by the labor and capital located in a state. This value originates from all industries in a state. [http://www.bea.gov/glossary/glossary.cfm?key\\_word=GDP&letter=G#GDP](http://www.bea.gov/glossary/glossary.cfm?key_word=GDP&letter=G#GDP)

Kentucky's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) increased to a record \$156.45 billion during 2008. This represents an increase of over \$44 billion in Kentucky's GDP since 2000. Kentucky's GDP for 2007 was \$152.1 billion.

Manufacturing remains Kentucky's largest industrial sector, but has declined as a percentage of Kentucky's economy over the past years. During 1998, manufacturing composed 26.6% (\$29 billion) of Kentucky's GDP. In 2008, manufacturing declined to 18.4% of Kentucky's GDP (\$28.8 billion) and became the only primary industrial sector that has declined from its 1998 level. However, the manufacturing sector has shown an increase of \$3.5 billion over the last five years from the 2003 level of \$25.3 billion.

## Gross Domestic Product (GDP) Estimates by County: 2007

Kentucky's economic strength varies noticeably by county and region. Higher educational attainment, population density, and infrastructure, examples: airports, interstate highways, public universities, and so on, correlate very closely with economic activity within a region.

- The top five (5) counties (Jefferson, Fayette, Christian, Boone, and Kenton) accounted for almost 51% of Kentucky's total GDP and over 31% of the state's population;
  - Jefferson County (28.1%) and Fayette County (9.6%) generated 37.8% of Kentucky's economy and combined for 23.3% of Kentucky's population;
  - The bottom five (5) counties (Robertson, Owsley, Elliott, Menifee and Carlisle) accounted for 0.17% of Kentucky's total GDP and 0.61% of the state's population;
  - Robertson County contributed the least to the state's Gross Domestic Product, approximately \$33 million;
  - The most productive counties on a per capita basis were Christian, Hancock, Carroll, Jefferson, and Boone; and
  - The least productive counties on a per capita basis were Elliott, Edmonson, Spencer, Owsley and Menifee.

### **Employment**

Kentucky's employment/unemployment levels vary significantly throughout the state. Regional location and community populations typically have a direct relationship with employment/unemployment rates. The central and north central Kentucky counties which are inclusive of Louisville, Lexington, and the northern Kentucky metro areas tend to have the lowest unemployment rates and the more vibrant labor markets.

### **Kentucky Exports 2008**

During 2008, Kentucky's total exports dropped slightly. Kentucky exported over \$19.09 billion of goods during 2008, ranking 23<sup>rd</sup> among the 50 states and the District of Columbia in total exports. Kentucky's exports accounted for 1.5 percent of the nation's total exports in 2008 compared to 1.2 percent in 2000. Kentucky's exports have increased almost 100% since 2000 and by 46% since 2004. Kentucky exported \$4,479 of goods per capita during 2008. Kentucky ranked ninth nationally in exports per capita for 2008.

In 2008, Kentucky's exports added over \$4.6 billion to the Commonwealth's direct state gross domestic product and directly created 52,000 jobs. The exports generated an estimated \$379 million in direct state and local taxes. Additionally, Kentucky's 2008 exports generated an estimated \$293 million (indirect) and \$286 million (induced) in state and local taxes. (Excluding educational taxes)

Manufactured goods account for 96.3 percent (\$18.38 billion) of Kentucky's exports. North America, Western Europe, China, Japan, Brazil, Taiwan and Singapore continue to be the major markets for Kentucky products in the global economy.

Transportation equipment ranked as Kentucky's top export in 2008. Kentucky's export of transportation equipment totaled \$6.76 billion, approximately 35 percent of Kentucky's total exports. Chemicals remained Kentucky's second largest export with respect to the value of export shipments. Chemical exports valued \$3.5 billion during 2008.

Machinery and computer/electronic products are Kentucky's third and fourth largest exports, respectively. Transportation equipment, chemicals, computer and electronic products, machinery and primary metal products account for 71.4 percent of Kentucky's 2008 exports.

Canada is Kentucky's largest foreign market with exports totaling \$5.9 billion, or 31 percent of Kentucky's exports, in 2008. Second is France, with \$1.9 billion of goods, followed by Mexico (\$1.2 billion), the United Kingdom (\$1.2 billion) and Japan (\$840 million).
